Grandma's Scotcheroos Recipe

Ingredients:

1 cup corn syrup

1 cup peanut butter

1/3 cup sugar

6 cups Rice Krispies cereal

11 oz. pkg. milk chocolate chips

11 oz. pkg. butterscotch chips

Instructions:

1. Heat syrup, peanut butter, and sugar 5. Spread over the Scotcheroos and reover medium heat until smooth and sugar is dissolved (just heat

through, no need to boil). Remove from heat.

- 2. Pour peanut butter and syrup mixture over 6 cups of cereal. Stir until completely coated.
- 3. Spread in a buttered 9 by 13 baking dish. Pack down slightly.
- 4. Melt chocolate chips and butterscotch chips in a double boiler or microwave.
- frigerate until set, about 30 minutes. Cut into bars.
